



Sisterhood Circle Frequently Ask Questions

1. There are more Sorors (over the limit) that are interested in the circle I've formed. How can they be included?

All Sisterhood Circles should be limited to 5 sorors; however, you can connect your circles. For instance, if you have a Sisterhood Circle named Sisters Together with 5 sorors, the second circle could be called Sisters Together Too with an additional 5 sorors and so on. We think by doing this, your goals can still be achieved.

2. Will the 1st presentation be available to the Sisterhood Circles?

3. Although I have taken on the task of “lead Soror,” how do I get the other Sorors to also want to participate? Ours was to be a circle in which all sorors are equal members, but no one wants to do much. How do I address this or get them more engaged?

We suggest that you invite your Sisterhood Circle sorors to listen to the Centennial Sisterhood Conference Call together and then decide if they want to continue with the Sisterhood Circle.

Yes, notification should be sent within 48 hours of submission of the Sisterhood Circle.

8. I have previously sent an email to Sisterhoodcircle@zphib2020.com but I have not received a response.

An email reply should be given within 48 hours. If you do not get a response, please send a follow-up email.

9. I lost contact with the lead of my circle. Is it possible to contact her through the site?

Yes, just send an email to Sisterhoodcircle@zphib2020.com . With the name of your Sisterhood Circle and we will connect you to the circle lead.
